Looking After Your Woodware

Wood is a natural organic material and unless you look after it correctly it will not last; treat it correctly and it will last for ages.

The wood has been treated with a mixture of wax and oil that has impregnated the surface and sealed it, but I suggest you give it a wash before you use it.

Bowls and plates will take hot food fine, but I suggest you avoid hot drinks with the beakers and goblets.

Wash the woodware in warm water and soap as you would anything else but don't leave it to soak and do not ever put in a dishwasher, dry off after washing.

Do not leave in full sun especially after washing or when wet.

Do not expose to rapid changes in temperature or differentials in temperature ie don't leave a wet bowl near a fire so one half rapidly gets hot and the other stays relatively cool.
